## 2022-2023 Faith Academy Test Scores Released

For the second year, Faith Academy students continue to achieve grade level proficient scores (level 3 or higher on the end-of-grade tests) in reading (55\%) and math ( $60 \%$ ) that are higher than the North Carolina average proficient scores in reading (50\%) and math (53\%). Faith grade level proficient scores on the science tests (67\%) that are only given in grades 5 and 8 mirrored the state performance (68\%). 2022-2023 was the first year Faith administered the grade 8 science end-ofgrade test. For all subjects, $58 \%$ of Faith students were grade level proficient compared to the state (54\%).

Faith students also continued to top the state average in reading and math for students who are on track to be career and college ready (level 4 or 5 on the end-of-grade tests). The percent of proficient scores were: All subjects - Faith 39\%; NC 36\%. Reading - Faith 37\%; NC 31\%. Math Faith $37 \%$; NC $35 \%$. Faith students ( $50 \%$ ) fell behind the state ( $57 \%$ ) in science.

After exceeding the school's growth target in its first year of operation and thus setting a higher benchmark, Faith students did not meet the overall expected growth target last year. However, Faith students continued to show strong growth and achievement in math. This is particularly encouraging since math performance has been historically lower than student performance in reading. Faith students who are on track to be career and college ready in math also met their long term interim goal set by the State Board of Education. Long term goals show progress toward meeting North Carolina's 12-year goals and for reducing the achievement gap between subgroups of students in reading and math. Economically disadvantaged students at Faith (170), who often face challenges to be academically successful, also met their growth target for the first time last year.

For the second year, Faith Academy earned a School Performance Grade of C, based on a score of 60 derived from the state formula. The State Board of Education is currently working on a new formula that will utilize additional measures to determine School Performance Grades. The goal is to improve the formula to reflect school performance more accurately and to tell the story of what schools do every day to create and maintain a safe, positive school experience for students.
